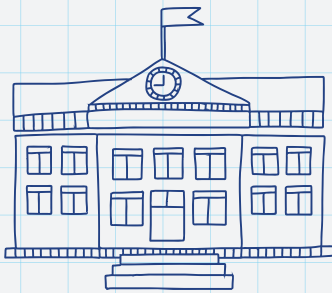


# NATRE SURVEY 2019: KEY FINDINGS

## Number of schools flouting Religious Education rises

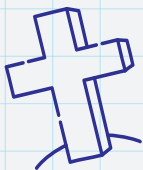


# 50%

In 50% of Academy schools without a religious character, pupils are not receiving the Religious Education they entitled to at Key Stage 4 (16 year olds).

# 40%

In almost 40% of community schools pupils are not receiving the Religious Education they are entitled to at Key Stage 4 (16 year olds).

of schools have had parents withdraw their children from Religious Education.

of year 11 students receive no RE when RS is optional at GCSE.



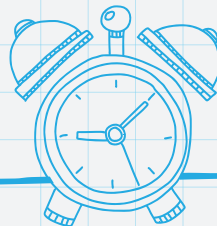
# 36%
