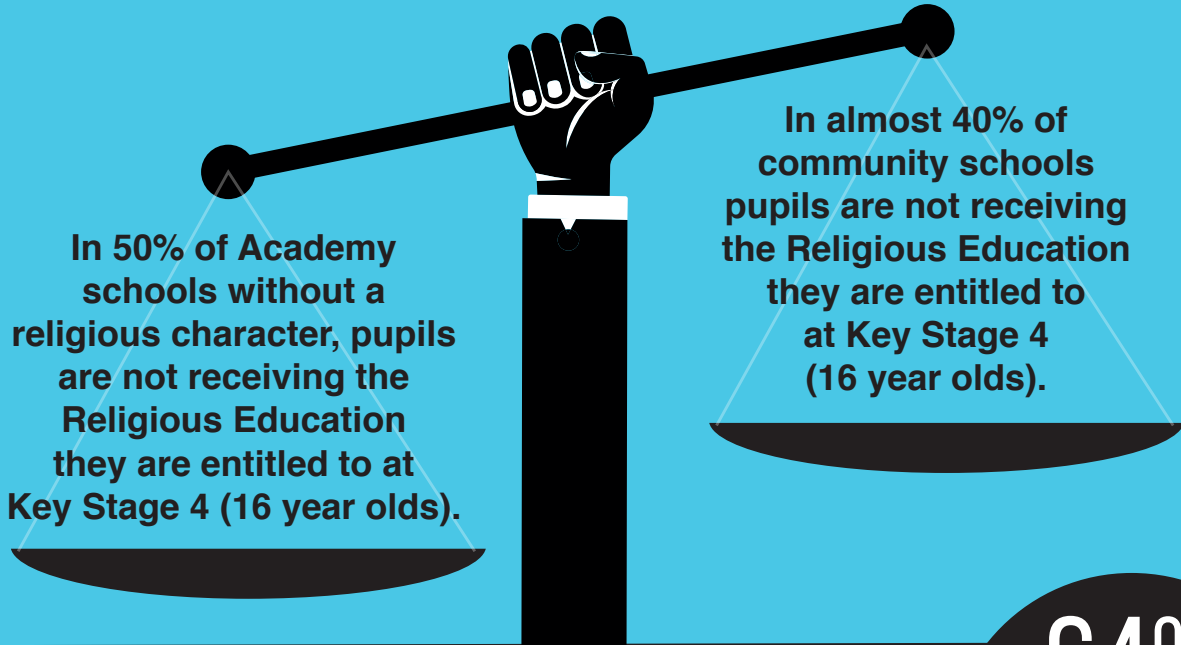


# NATRE SURVEY 2019: KEY FINDINGS

## NUMBER OF SCHOOLS FLOUTING RELIGIOUS EDUCATION RISES



# 32%

of schools have had parents **withdraw** their children from Religious Education.

## WHY...

Not wanting to learn about Islam

Our family religion is... so I don't want them studying this

Want them to study a different subject

In over 36% of schools, a fifth of RE lessons are taught by teachers of other subjects.

# 21%

of schools teach GCSE RS in less than the teaching time required to cover the syllabus

# 64%

of year 11 students receive no RE when RS is optional at GCSE.

# 28%

of schools have declining numbers of specialist RE teachers

663 secondary RE teachers in England and Wales were surveyed in May/June 2019
